The breaches were so serious that there would have been a death had there been a blaze in the building.

Fire safety problems found in 300 homes in estate

A hotel has been fined £210,000 after a guest was forced to escape through a window
Offences included defective fire doors, blocked escape routes and no staff training.

Wedding venue owners are charged over £23,000 for putting lives at risk
They will appear in court facing charges of 9 serious breaches of the Order 2005

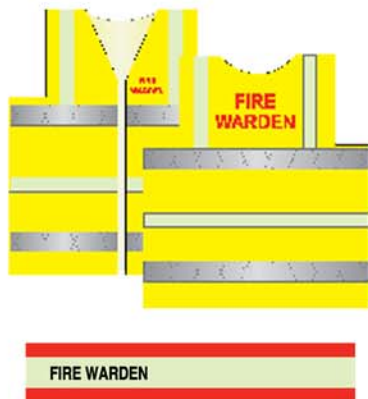
