Fines & Convictions

> **The owner of an HMO has been fined; £7600**

The convictions were;

1. Failure to provide a fire alarm - £1500
2. Blocked fire exit - £2000
3. Fire doors were not fitted with self closing devices - £1000
4. 2 x fire doors weren't maintained to appropriate standard - £2000
5. Damaged electrical socket and exposed wiring - £1000
6. Failure to provide info to the fire authority when requested - £100



> **A former hotel owner has been fined almost; £44,000**

Convictions included; Fire alarm not working, no smoke alarms or detectors in rooms while some detectors were covered with plastic bags. Escape routes were blocked with large items which included a wardrobe and fire doors had no self closing devices.

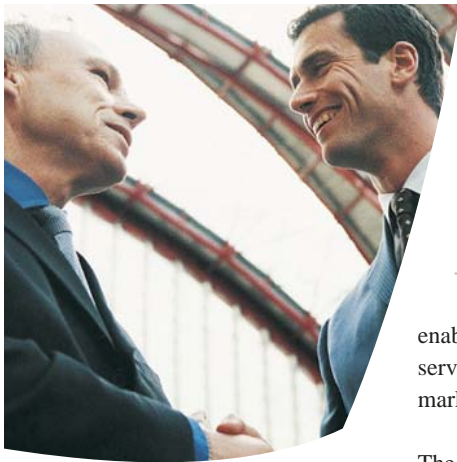
> **A landlord pleaded guilty to 3 charges after a fire in his building killed 2 people**

He pleaded guilty to; failure to make a suitable fire risk assessment, failure to ensure a safe evacuation and insufficient fire detectors and alarms
